Survivor Rights and Options Notification

If you have experienced sexual violence, dating violence, domestic violence, or stalking, you have the following rights and options:

Your Immediate Rights

- You are entitled to medical attention, counseling, and advocacy support.
- You can report the incident to the police, the school, both, or neither.
- You may request protective measures such as changes to your schedule, classroom seating, or interactions with the accused.

Your Rights

- To have the incident taken seriously and responded to promptly.
- To receive a thorough, fair, and impartial investigation.
- To be free from retaliation.
- To access interim supportive measures, even if no formal complaint is filed.
- To pursue school disciplinary proceedings and/or criminal prosecution.

Confidentiality

Your privacy will be respected. You may request confidentiality, though some disclosures may require action to ensure campus safety.
